The agency within the Department that has responsibility specifically for licensed and unlicensed psychotherapists is the: **Department of Regulatory Agencies, Mental Health Section, 1560 Broadway, Suite 1350, Denver, Colorado 80202, (303) 894-7800.** As your therapist, I have bolded the description(s) that pertain to me: **Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist** must hold a master's degree and have two years of post-master's supervision. 1. You are entitled to receive information from me about my methods of therapy, the techniques I use, the duration of your therapy (if I can determine it), and my fee structure. 2. You can seek a second opinion or terminate therapy at any time. 3. Sexual intimacy between a therapist and a client is never appropriate. 4. Information provided by/to a client during therapy sessions is legally confidential if the therapist is licensed and I may not disclose the information without client's consent, except as provided in the confidentiality of the Mental Health Statute (C.R.S. § 12-43-218), the HIPPA Notice of Privacy Rights and certain other legal exceptions. You should be aware that provisions concerning the disclosure of confidential communications do not apply to any delinquency or criminal proceedings, except as provided in C.R.S. § 13-90-107. I will identify any exceptions to you if any such situation arises while the therapeutic relationship exists or after we have terminated the therapeutic relationship.
